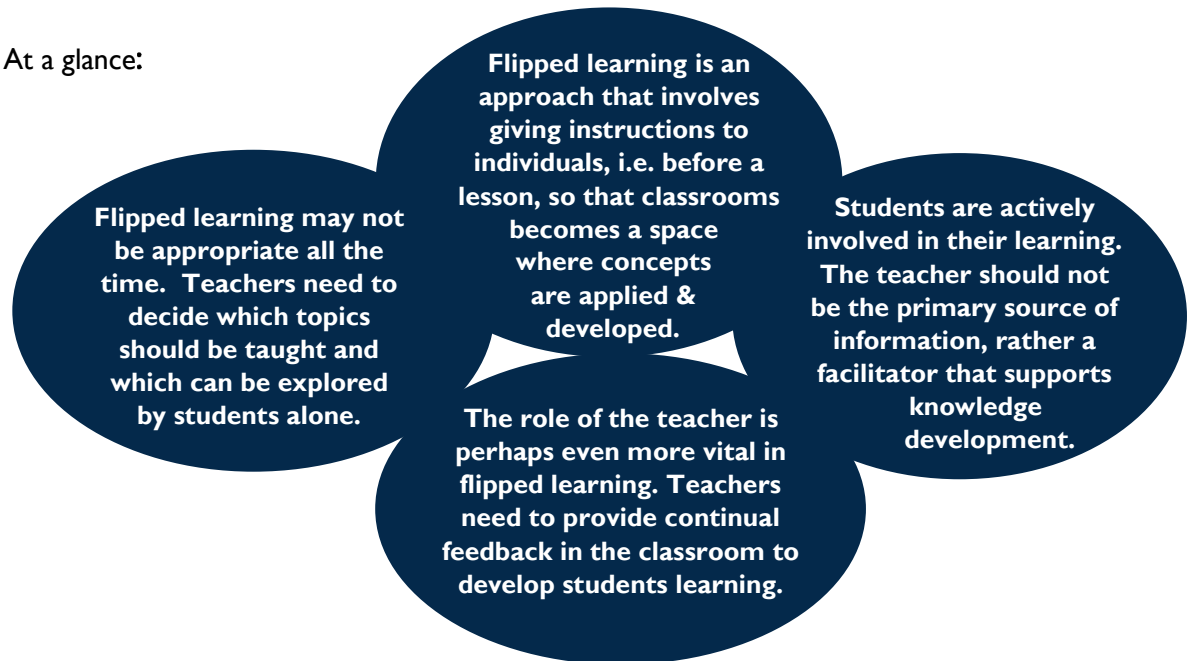

Key Information:

- Students should prepare to participate in class activities outside of the classroom. They would then get feedback on this during the lesson.
- By providing students with resources to gain a basic understanding before they enter the classroom, it enables classroom time to be used more effectively to deepen understanding and apply concepts.
- Research has shown flipped learning to be effective in increasing attendance and improving grades.

Ways that you can use this in your classroom today:

- Prepare students for this approach by setting expectations. Perhaps the independent work could be scaffolded initially to support with this.
- Think of activities that students can do at home to construct knowledge and activities they can do in class to apply this knowledge.
- Activities in class could involve problem-solving or discussion with peers.
